Re: Applications for Prospect Ridge Congregate Housing

The Ridgefield Housing Authority is accepting applications for Prospect Ridge Congregate Housing. This program, funded by the State of Connecticut, Department of Economic and Community Development in cooperation with the Town of Ridgefield Housing Authority is designed to aid frail elderly persons to obtain adequate housing. Basic requirements for entry into the program are as follows:

- 1) Applicant must be sixty-two years of age or older.
- 2) Applicant's gross income must currently be less than \$40,600 per year.

The apartment units consist of a small kitchen, living room, bedroom and bath. There is a central dining room where one meal a day is served at noon. There is a maximum of one hour of housekeeping per unit per week provided and someone is on duty 24 hours a day to monitor the alarm systems which include a smoke/fire alarm system and a call for aid alarm system.
